The iPROMEDAI Young Scientist Forum will provide interactive discussion sessions on topics that concern every Early Stage Researcher in the field of Advanced Antimicrobial Biomaterials. It will provide an interactive networking platform to share knowledge on and exchange experience about career opportunities, grant possibilities, scientific communication as well as work for/collaborate with industry.

The event will take place 17 and 18 September 2017 in the Conference Cultural Centre "Thessaloniki Concert Hall", Thessaloniki, Greece.

Travel Grants

The COST action TD1305 "iPROMEDAI" will offer grants to active Early Stage Researchers (MSc students, PhD candidates, and postdocs) from European countries participating in the action. You can check whether your country is one of the members at the COST website. The maximum total amount for the grant is EUR 800 to (partly) cover your flight, accommodation (daily allowance of max. EUR 100), meals and public transport costs. The grant can only be claimed by the COST association afterwards when the YSF is finished. For more details, please visit www.cost.eu/Vademecum.

Of note, participation is open for all ESRs, so you can also participate in the YSF if your institute or country in not part of iPROMEDAI but then your expenses will not be covered. This might be of particular interest for ESRs participating the EUROMAT 2017.

Admission

The workshop is limited to 50 participants to allow interactive discussion sessions. In case of over-subscription, the organizers will select candidates based on geographical distribution and research activities. The selection will be final and not negotiable.
